

## **COURSE ETIQUETTE-SOCIETIES**

**Prior to playing a stroke or making a practice swing, the player should ensure that no-one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like which may be moved by the stroke or swing.**

**In taking practice swings players should avoid damage to the course, particularly the tees, by removing divots.**

**Please replace all divots and repair pitch marks in greens.**

**Keep trolleys off approaches and greens.**

**Smooth out bunkers carefully after playing.**

**Play without delay.**

**When searching for a lost ball – call following players through immediately and do not play until they are out of range.**

**If you have lost one clear hole in front and are holding up following players, YOU MUST give way.**

**Do not practice anywhere on the course except the official practice area.**

**Be a considerate player. Enjoy your golf and make sure you do not upset other players' enjoyment.**

### **N.B.**

- a. **Work May Be Taking Place On The Course, e.g. Hollowtining and during these periods Temporary Greens may be in Operation**
- b. **For Health & Safety reasons, e.g. FOG the course may need to close for certain periods until it is deemed safe for play to commence.**
- c. **PROCEDURE FOR SUSPENSION OF PLAY:-  
Two bursts of the Klaxon. (Complete current hole or mark ball, and return to Clubhouse).**

### **PROCEDURE FOR CESSATION OF PLAY**

**One long burst of the Klaxon. (Stop play immediately and return to Clubhouse).**
