VISITOR FEES AS FROM 1 APRIL 2009

1. Visitor not playing with Member - £36

Visitors, playing with Member, may pay the preferential guest rate (shown below)
a maximum of 6 times per playing season.

They can be signed in a further 6 times per playing season at a £10 surcharge.

2. Visitor playing with Member - £15

3. Visitor (1 only or 2 after 12.00 noon) playing £20 before 12 00 noon with a Member Saturday and Sunday. £18 after 12 00 noon Bank Holidays and Christmas Period (24/12-2/1 inc)

**4. Society Fees - 18/27 holes - £30, 36 holes – by arrangement
(£2 disc for groups of 20 or more)**

ALL FEES ARE INCLUSIVE OF VAT & PERSONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE PREMIUM

- A** Members must accompany introduced visitors during play at all times.
- B** Members are not permitted to sign in and then play with a visitor if not personally known to them.
- C** Weekdays (except Friday pm). Members may introduce not more than three visitors (only one Junior visitor under the age of 18 years), all of whom may pay the relevant reduced green fee.
- D** Friday (pm). Members may introduce not more than 2 visitors from 12 noon (only one Junior visitor under the age of 18 years), who may pay the relevant reduced green fee.
- E** No visitor may play during week-end, and/or Bank Holiday unless with a member.
- F** Saturdays, Sundays, Bank Holidays and Christmas Period (24/12 to 2/1 inclusive)
Members (including Country and Junior) may sign in one visitor only (2 visitors after 12 noon, but only one Junior visitor under the age of 18 years), having previously sought approval from the Professional or Secretary. (Refer separate sheet for Junior restrictions according to handicap). During the Christmas period no casual visitors will be permitted.

- G** No Restricted Member may play during week-ends unless with a Member eligible to play at that time (having previously obtained approval from the Professional or Secretary), and on payment of the appropriate green fee.
- H** Guests may only play 6 times per season (1 April to 31 March inclusive), at the preferential guest rate shown above which covers week-days and week-ends. They can be signed in a further 6 times per season at a £10 surcharge
- I** Members and visitors should commence play off the 1st tee or 10th tee unless otherwise directed by the Main Committee or Professional.
- J** Non-members may not play on the practice pitch after a lesson without paying a green fee.
- K** On men's competition days, visitors may not normally commence play before 3.30 pm.

**RESTRICTED TIMES OF PLAY FOR JUNIORS AT WEEKENDS, BANK
HOLIDAYS AND CHRISTMAS PERIOD (24/12 TO 2/1 INCLUSIVE)**

Casual Junior visitors

Not permitted

Junior Members/Guests

Members (including Full, Country & Junior) may sign in one Junior guest (under 18 years of age) only during above periods, having previously sought approval from the Professional or Secretary.

Junior Members introducing non-junior visitors will be restricted in their times of play according to the handicap of the Junior Member.

Junior Members introducing Junior visitors will be restricted in their times of play according to the highest handicap of the group including the Junior Member.

On men's competition days, visitors may not normally commence play before 3.30 pm.

Handicap 28 or less – male)
Handicap 36 or less – female)

No restrictions.

Handicap 29 & above – male)
Handicap 37 & above – female)

Not permitted to play until after 2.30 pm (after 12.00 noon outside of BST) at weekends and Bank Holidays unless accompanied by a Full or Country Member.

RESTRICTED TIMES OF PLAY FOR JUNIORS DURING WEEK

Junior Members/Guests

Members (including Full, Restricted, Country & Junior) may introduce not more than 2 visitors from 12.00 noon on a Friday (only one Junior visitor under the age of 18 years), and not more than 3 visitors at other times during the week (only one Junior visitor under the age of 18 years), all of whom may pay the relevant reduced green fee.

NO RESTRICTIONS

GENERAL

- **WHEN A JUNIOR UNDER 12 YEARS OF AGE ATTENDS THE COURSE OR CLUBHOUSE, IT IS RECOMMENDED THE JUNIOR PRESENTS HIMSELF/HERSELF TO THE PROFESSIONAL, MAKING THE PROFESSIONAL, WHEN POSSIBLE, AWARE OF THEIR ATTENDANCE.**
- **JUNIORS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS AND NOT PLAYING WITH AN ADULT, SHOULD NOT REMAIN ON THE COURSE AFTER DUSK**
- **JUNIORS AGED 10 YEARS AND UNDER MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES**
- **RECOMMENDED THAT JUNIORS WITH HANDICAPS ABOVE 24 SHOULD TAKE A RULES INSTRUCTION BY THE JUNIOR ORGANISER OR COMPETITIONS CHAIRMAN.**

GUESTS/VISITORS PLAYING THE COURSE

Junior visitors who are not playing members of another golf club must undertake an assessment of capability with the club professional before they can play the course with a Junior Member.

Guests may only play 12 times per season (1 April to 31 March inclusive), which covers week-days and week-ends.
