## **BEGINNERS AND JUNIORS DRESS CODE**

Fulford Heath Golf Club wishes to welcome and encourage people to experience the game of golf and the benefits of belonging to a golf club.

We offer coaching and starter sessions for people taking up the game of golf.

One of the benefits of our Club is an environment where good standards of dress and behaviour are expected, which sets an example for young people.

However, it is also recognised that most beginners, perhaps aiming to practice or play golf for the first time, are unlikely to have the appropriate dress or footwear that is normally required.

Accordingly the Dress Code and Policy, which remains valid for players (both Members and visitors to the Club) is varied for beginners, to make it easier for them. The policy on etiquette remains valid for all players, including juniors.

- Up to and including age 15, beginners are welcome to wear smart casual clothing and footwear when practicing under authorised supervision or when entering the Clubhouse.
- All other beginners are expected to adhere to the normal Club policy on dress, with the exception that they can wear training shoes or equivalent when practicing under authorised supervision.
- All beginners will be expected to wear clean clothing and footwear in the Clubhouse.

This variation is designed to encourage people to learn to play and participate in golf at Fulford Heath Golf Club.

- In recognition of the footwear that is available for young people, any junior up to and including 15 years of age may wear smart clean training shoes in the Clubhouse.
