



## **Buggy Policy**

**To comply with Disability Legislation the Club are introducing an ‘orange route’ to enable disabled golfers (members and visitors) to use a buggy when, due to adverse conditions, they would not normally be allowed on the course.**

**If any golfer, including blue badge holders, consider they need mechanical assistance to play during these periods they must obtain a medical certificate from their doctor –Templates are available from the office and on the web site.**

**Please note, there could still be occasions when it may be unsafe to use a buggy and at such times access to the course may be prohibited, a reduced number of holes may be in- play or the 90 degree rule might be in operation.**

**The new Buggy Policy and ‘orange route’ will be available for members to view in the clubhouse during October. In the interim if any member requires specific clarification they should contact the Chairman.**
